

Travis County Sheriff's Reserve Association (TCSROA) Steve Titsworth Scholarship Guidelines

The Travis County Sheriff's Reserve Association Steve Titsworth Scholarship is intended to provide financial support to students who are graduating high school seniors and who will attend a two-year or four-year college or university, or trade, technical or vocational school.

The recipients must be graduating seniors from an accredited Texas High School who is the child of a Travis County Sheriff's Office employee.

1. An applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher. If the applicant intends to enroll in a college or university, they must provide an ACT or SAT score.
2. Scholarship recipient selection(s) will be made without regard to race, age, gender, religion, political beliefs, or any other factor which would constitute unfair or illegal discrimination.
3. Scholarship recipient selection(s) will be made with consideration to academic achievement, financial need, and campus and community involvement. Applicants who fulfill all of the criteria will be given priority.
4. A scholarship applicant must be a U. S. citizen and must plan to attend a college, university, technical, trade or vocational school in the United States.
5. Applicants who have already received a full four-year scholarship will not be considered.
6. The scholarship application must be completed in full. The Travis County Sheriff's Reserve Association Scholarship Board will not consider an incomplete application.
7. Students must submit an application and all required information no later than 1 April.
8. All recipients must enroll at a college, university, technical, trade or vocational school in the fall following graduation. The scholarship check will be made payable both to the recipient and the school.
9. The scholarship amount and the number of scholarships to be awarded each year will be decided by the TCSROA.
10. Relatives of the current TCSROA Scholarship Board are ineligible for consideration.
11. Decisions of the TCSROA Scholarship Board are final in regard to the scholarship application and selection process.
